SHREWSBURY SCHOOLS HALF MARATHON

31 children from Weston Lullingfields CE Primary School signed up to this challenge back in October last year and we are just 5 weeks away from the big event now!

The 2019 Shropshire Primary Schools Half Marathon in association with Shrewsbury Half Marathon is part of the Schools Half Marathon Challenge and will enable children to complete their very own cumulative half marathon on race weekend. The first 12 miles of this exciting challenge are being completed at school and the final 1.1 miles are run at the Shropshire County Showground on Saturday 6th April 2019, starting at 9am. All children who have entered the event will be bringing home a wristband on Tuesday 5th March in recognition of having completed 6 miles so far.

Children will get the full race experience on the day including race bibs, a marshalled route, music and a start and finish line gantry, allowing them to enjoy the thrill of a big sporting event and to be cheered on by friends and family. As they cross the finish line, they are presented with their well-deserved Half Marathon medal.

Friends, family and supporters are encouraged to join us at Shropshire Country Showground on Saturday 6th April to cheer on our young runners! The school has funded all the entry fees for children to take part so please ensure that you have reserved the date in your diaries, as we are unable to get refunds. We look forward to seeing all our young runners collect their t-shirt and finishers medal on the day.
