Thank you to everyone for your cooperation with the changes we have made to the morning entrance routine since the start of term. The safeguarding and fire safety risks due to the number of people and congestion within the school building first thing in the morning have now been much reduced and children and staff have been able to establish a much calmer and more prompt start to the learning activities for the day. As a reminder, pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 should be dropped off at the rear entrance door from where

they will be supervised by school staff. Parents of children in Nursery and Reception year may still accompany their children into school. The rear door will be open between 8:40 and 8:50am – should you arrive after this time then please bring children to the main school entrance. If you need to drop children off before 8:40am our breakfast club is open from 8:00am onwards – children should not be left unsupervised on the playground before 8:40am. If you have any messages for school staff, please let Mrs MacDonald in the school office know and she can ensure that they are passed on. She will also be happy to make an appointment for you to see teaching staff or myself if you would like a more in-depth conversation with any of us.
