

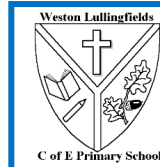

PSHE EYFS PSED (R) Build constructive and respectful relationships, think about the perspectives of others, manage own needs, express feelings and consider others, identify and moderate feelings Y1/2 Digital wellbeing – online safety

MATHS EYFS Mathematics Count objects beyond 10 (R). Count objects and actions to 10. Composition to 10. Subitise up to 5. Numerals 1-10. 1 more and 1 less than a number between 1-5. Explore pattern and building sets. Continue, copy and create repeated patterns. Identify 2D and 3D shapes and characteristics, compose and decompose shapes. Compare length, weight and capacity. Y1 Reading and matching numbers 0-20, times tables, Compare length, weight and capacity, number bonds, halving, telling the time Y2 Comparing numbers, Place value, times tables, fractions, telling the time, using rulers, addition/subtraction, multiplication/division.

SCIENCE Acorns will learn about identifying animals and seasonal changes.

GEOGRAPHY EYFS Understanding the world – exploring and understanding that some places are special in communities. Recognise similarities and differences between lives in different countries. Draw information from a simple map.
Y1/2 Animals around the world. We will learn about the seven continents of the world through the native animals.
